
The Town Board of the Town of Waubeek, Pepin County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 7.30(1), Wis, stats., to adopt this ordinance.


This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the selection of 2 (or more) sets of officials to work at different times on each election day as follows:


- A. There shall be 2 shifts for the Chief election inspector and 4 shifts for election worker on all election days. For the Chief election inspector, the first shift shall commence at 6:15 am and end at 1:00 pm. The second shift shall commence at 1:00 pm and end with completion of all required election day duties that follow the closure of the polls. For the two election workers the 4 shifts are to be served between the hours of 6:30 am and 10:00 am, 10:00 am and 1:00 pm and 1:00 pm till 4:00 pm and 4:00 pm till closure of the polls.


This ordinance is effective on publication or posting.
