GCS is the software Bernadette uses for the property tax statements, the county is upgrading in 2022 so we must also, cost will go from \$330 a year to \$550

Bernadette is also working with a rep at ALLPAID Credit Card Processing, she will be doing training so that this can be an option for the payment of taxes. There will be no cost to the town but the citizen will pay 2.65% interest. The plan is to have a link on our website.

Property tax payments will no longer be accepted by Bernadette at her home. She asked for the town to purchase a lockbox to be placed next to her house so payments can be dropped off this way, and if a receipt is requested we will ask for a self addressed stamped envelope to be included

Glen updated the board regarding the LRIP program, for our town with only ¾ mile of black top we would have to match dollar for dollar. Besides which it can only be used for new construction.
